- 4- Waiting area post blood donation

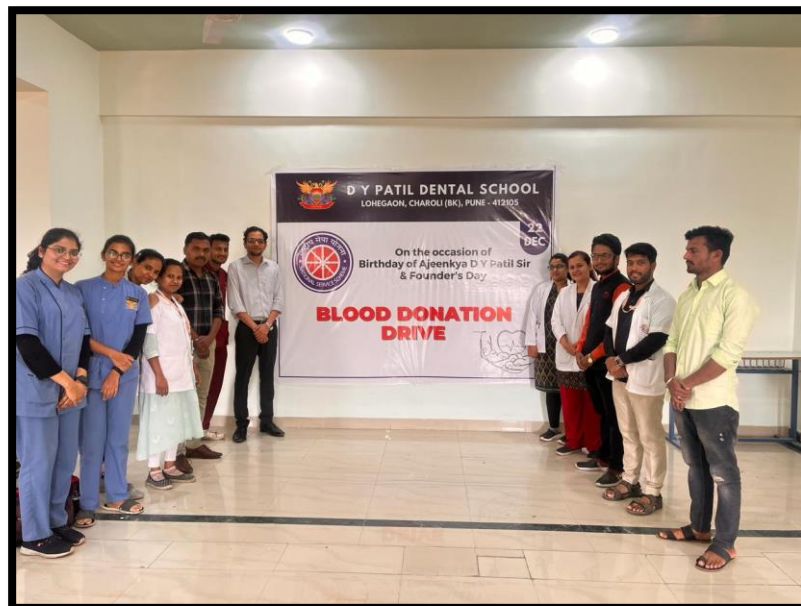



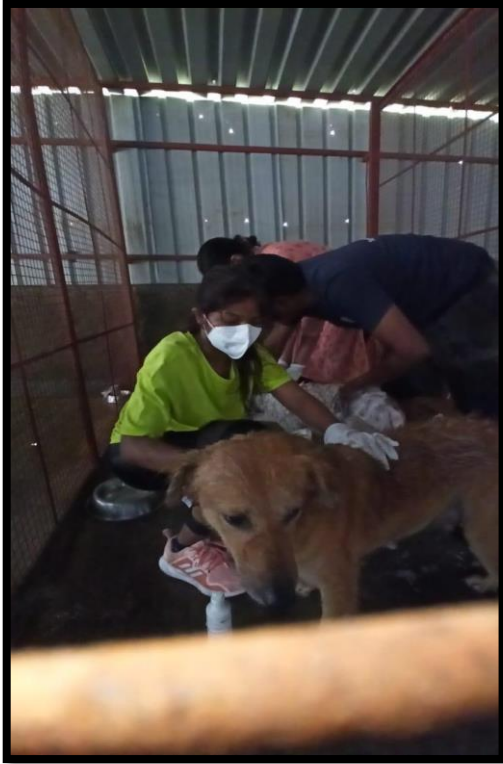

The first batch of 20 Childrens arrived at 10.00 am and their registration details were recorded on the case paper. Treatment started around 10.30 am. A second group of 20 children's arrived around 12.00 pm. NSS volunteers were instructed to carry out only non-invasive procedures. The treatment carried out for the children were Fluoride application, Pit and Fissure sealant application, Scaling and polishing and routine restorative procedures.

The children enquired extensively about routine oral hygiene measures. A tooth brushing demonstration along with diet counselling was given to all children by NSS volunteers using models. The response and cooperation from the concerned authorities was commendable.

Distribution of the case record was done before the beginning of the dental camp, so that children knew date and time when to come and they didn't have to wait the whole day, what prevents aggression and is more comfortable. The treatment camp ended at 3.30 pm.
